Corporate Sponsorship Policy

The National Alliance for Public Safety GIS Foundation (NAPSG Foundation) is a national 501 (c)(3) organization dedicated to education and research on public safety communications and management techniques, including but not limited to Geographic Information Systems. NAPSG Foundation may partner with corporations on events, programs, educational offerings, and research studies. The following policy was developed to help guide and more clearly define a standard framework for our corporate partnerships.

- NAPSG Foundation Board of Directors is comprised of public safety practitioners. Corporations are not allowed to hold positions on the Board of Directors. Should a member of the NAPSG Foundation Board of Director also work for a private corporation, they will be required to sign and adhere to the Conflict of Interest Policy.
- NAPSG Foundation will not endorse in any of its materials, literature or events any specific product or product name. Written materials produced by NAPSG Foundation may list a corporation's name but may not, under any circumstance, provide endorsement of a specific product.
- NAPSG Foundation will not, under any circumstance, link from its website to any product-specific information. However, the NAPSG Foundation may exhibit the names and logos of corporate partners (with permission from such entities) and provide a link to their general websites.
- All contributions and grants provided to the NAPSG Foundation for programs or materials are unrestricted public safety education and research grants. While NAPSG Foundation may seek input from time to time from its corporate sponsors, NAPSG Foundation maintains final approval and copyright over all program and material development and speaker selection.
- At its discretion, NAPSG Foundation may deem it necessary to enter into specific agreements with a corporate sponsor in the form of a Memorandum of Understanding for the purpose of recognizing common objectives and to provide specific guidance on how the corporate sponsor may provide support.

- All materials and programs developed by NAPSG Foundation are the property of NAPSG Foundation and must carry the NAPSG Foundation copyright, and as such, cannot be changed, modified or duplicated without prior written permission from NAPSG Foundation.
- The NAPSG Foundation may accept corporate sponsors for particular events, programs, or other activities. The NAPSG Foundation Board of Directors retains the right to determine if the engagement is co-hosted and/or co-branded with the relative corporate sponsors.
- All speakers at NAPSG Foundation programs and events will be required to disclose their relationship with a corporate sponsor.
- NAPSG Foundation will not, under any circumstance, accept contributions from corporations, when such contributions are contingent on any public policy position and/or public policy activity. NAPSG Foundation maintains total independence and ultimate authority over its policy-making activities separate and apart from any corporate partnership.
- NAPSG Foundation reserves the right to sever any corporate partnership with, and return contributions from, an entity that participates in public policy activities that NAPSG Foundation deems offensive or that are in significant conflict with NAPSG Foundation public policy activities and/or positions.
- Any corporate partner wishing to reference NAPSG Foundation or any NAPSG Foundation project, publication or position must first seek the prior review and written approval from the NAPSG Foundation.
- NAPSG Foundation will not sell or release its mailing and/or email list to its corporate partners.
