

## 2016 National Geospatial Preparedness Summit

## Travel Scholarship Application

**Scholarship Program Intent:** NAPSG is pleased to offer a limited number of travel scholarships to support participation by local, state, and tribal practitioners in the 2016 National Geospatial Preparedness Summit (NGPS). The Summit will be held on September 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> in Washington, DC.

The NGPS Scholarship Program is intended to aid practitioners who would not be able to attend otherwise due to lack of travel funding. Scholarship applications will be reviewed on a bi-weekly basis, and all applicants will be notified as to whether their application has been accepted or denied.

**Applicant Eligibility:** Scholarship applicants must be active-duty local, state, or tribal public safety or GIS practitioners. An applicant must officially represent a local or state government agency or tribal organization. Public safety refers to, but is not limited to: fire service, emergency medical services, law enforcement, search & rescue, emergency management, 911 dispatch, public health, animal emergency response, mass care, and fusion centers. Eligible applicants must be more than 100 miles from Washington, DC.

**Eligible Expenses:** The NGPS Scholarship Program will provide a \$500 scholarship that can be used for any travel expense, which will be sent to recipients within 30 days after the Summit.
