
THE STORY OF MUTUAL AID NET

Value


- A master list of typed resources managed with and at the local level
- Includes both Tier-I and Tier-II resources
- Started with just ESF-4 assets and has grown
- Provides a single database to catalog and manage all the required information needed to facilitate the statewide deployment of mutual aid resources

 - * 39,568




The Legacy System



Functionality


- Resources By department/agency

- Manages Mission Ready Packages (MRP) to support a roll up

DEPLOYMENT OF AN ID MANAGEMENT SYSTEM


