COMMON OPERATION PLATFORM







Community Lifelines

National Response Framework Update (Fourth Edition)

A lifeline is a sector that provides an indispensable service that enables the continuous operation of critical business and government functions, and is critical to human health and safety, or economic security.

Why a lifelines construct?

Decision-makers must rapidly determine the scope, complexity, and interdependent impacts of a disaster. Applying the lifelines construct allows decision-makers to:

- Prioritize, sequence, and focus response efforts towards maintaining or restoring the most critical services and infrastructure
- Utilize a common lexicon to facilitate unity of purpose across all stakeholders
- Promote a response that facilitates unity of purpose and better communication amongst the whole community (Federal, state, tribal, territorial, and local governments, and private sector and non-governmental entities)
- Clarify which components of the disaster are complex (multifaceted) and/or complicated (difficult), requiring cross-sector coordination

How will lifelines be used?

- Enhance the ability to gain, maintain, and communicate situational awareness for the whole community in responding to disasters
- Analyze impacts to the various lifelines and develop priority focus areas for each operational period during response
- Identify and communicate complex interdependencies to identify major limiting factors hindering stabilization
- Update the National Response Framework to reflect use of lifelines in response planning

What are the opportunities of lifelines?

- Enable a true unity of effort between government, non-governmental organizations, and the private sector, including infrastructure owners and operators
- Integrate preparedness efforts, existing plans, and identify unmet needs to better anticipate response requirements
- Refine reporting sources and products to enhance situational awareness, best determine capability gaps, and demonstrate progress towards stabilization

- Conducting statewide region calls to secure status of deployable resources.
- · Accepted EMAC proposals for USAR and Swift water resources from Mississippi and LA with teams staging Mobile Al.
- · Staging in Ocala for TF1 TF2 and TF6. Planned forward movement to impacted areas beginning midnight.
- . Forward Staging in Live Oak for TF 3 and TF4 for deployment beginning at midnight
- · Forward staging in Mobile, Al forTF5 for deployment beginning at midnight
- · Staging in place for TF8 with deployment beginning at midnight.
- Additional 4/9 assets beginning movement from south florida to staging in Ocala.
- . FFS Gold IMT has assumed operational responsibility of USAR.
- · Coordinating with FWC and other LEO for USAR team support.
- Requested/Acquired Federal USAR resources for deployment post storm.
- . Request for ice, water, MRE submitted for support of deployed 4/9 teams.

ESF-8 Health and Medical

- . DOH is supporting ESF-8 missions for Special Needs Shelters and patient requests.
- DOH has 18 Ambulance Strike Teams and 5 Ambulance Strike Teams through the Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC) ready to support with relief efforts and has requested 35 Special Needs Shelter Teams for additional shelter support.
- . DOH has contracted with the International Medical Corp to obtain additional resources that include nursing staff, hospital emergency department teams and a hospital augmentation team.
- 3 Federal Disaster Medical Assistance Teams have been requested.




Health and Medical

- . Monitoring Florida State Parks, with a focus on the Panhandle for potential closures.\Pre-event Windshield Surveys complete.
- Conducting outreach for high-priority regulated hazardous waste, in the Northwest District.
- . 235 Disaster Debris Management Sites (DDMS) have been pre-authorized for the counties addressed by the Governor's Executive Order.
- . The Florida Public Debris Reporting Tool is live.
- . Issued two emergency final orders to ensure recovery efforts are not hampered or delayed.
- FlaWARN to arrive to the Orlando Division of Water Call Center on 10/9/18.
- StormTracker for Water and Waste Water Incident Reporting, is live.
- . State Parks has been put on stand-by to assist in setting up a staging area for Duke Energy at Silver Springs state




By Branch - Missions by Lifeline and Status




